1. Selected applicants receive:

- Full tuition and other financial benefits worth up to **\$180,000**. NROTC Units are located at Over **160** of the nation's leading colleges and universities.
- \$250-\$400 a month tax-free spending money. \$750 stipend per year for books.

2. Basic eligibility requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 17 years of age by 01 September of their Freshman Year and not older than 23 by June 30th of the year you start college
- Complete high school/equivalent certificate
- Take the ACT or SAT test prior to deadline and receive at least the minimum scores listed below:

- *Not required for Nurse ROTC

5. Military Service requirements:

- **No obligation for first year of college**
- Upon completion of degree, receive commission as Ensign in the Navy Reserve
- Five year active duty obligation (Except Nurse NROTC and Marine Option of Four years.)

6. Benefits of NROTC:

- Free college tuition
- 100% employment upon graduation
- Opportunity to lead and manage personnel
- Unlimited travel opportunities
- 30 days paid vacation earned annually
- Excellent medical/dental benefits
