## CONCURRENT CLASSES ARE NOT FREE!! The parents are financially responsibility for the FEES/ and BOOKS for each class!

- 1. PARENT SIGNATURE on Parental Permission Form \*\*SUBMIT to HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR \* BEFORE your College admissions will be approved
- 2. Complete the college ADMISSIONS Application Online (RSU: www.rsu.edu)

<u>I understand that the student who is participating in Concurrent enrollment will NOT be on</u> the SHS campus UNTIL they are in a class scheduled on the high school campus.

**Concurrent classes are a choice and a privilege** available to high school juniors and seniors, **who meet the requirements** to participate. Students will need to take the ACT BEFORE enrolling at a College : with a minimum of ACT 19 Or the Pre-ACT score of Pre ACT of 19 AND Sub score of 19. This indicates Success in Concurrent. **Any concurrent student who fails to achieve the required 2.0 college GPA shall not be eligible for concurrent enrollment at any State System institution**, **The grade of D will Disqualify the student for continue Concurrent Enrollment**.

IF you are taking an IN PERSON Class, select the time of the class that will allow travel "ONE WAY". That means the student's day will either BEGIN at college 8AM or 8:30AM or END 2pm or later at College. <u>Parent Quick Glance for Concurrent College Enrollment--Final (002).pdf (ok.gov)</u>

Math and Science Classes are a full credit due to the Labs required, all other College Classes are .5 credit per semester. Every Concurrent grade becomes a part of the student's permanent High School Transcript, the College Grade may impact the GPA of the HS Student.

Concurrent Scheduling \* Only ONE class will be Dropped for ONE college class and only ONE class is dropped for travel. = 2 classes in high school for ONE concurrent class ONLY. Online courses will replace the first hours of the day or the last hours of the day.

I understand that the College class **GRADE will be posted on the High School Transcript**. I understand that the Oklahoma Department of Education guidelines are to Drop ONE High School class for ONE college class ONLY, and only ONE class will be dropped for ONE hour of Travel. I understand that no transportation is provided and the college class is **NOT FREE**, Parents are FINANCIALLY responsible for the FEES and BOOKS for the College Classes.

What Classes can be taken as Concurrent at college ? TAKE General Ed Classes SEE the : Degree Plan for the General Ed Classes. ALL concurrent Classes must be CORE, General ED Classes, Full Semester: no Basket weaving, rock climbing, skipping rope nonsense.

**SENIORS ONLY** can enroll in **COMP 1 AND COMP 2** \* This is a Dual Credit class for SENIOR English ONLY if taken during **Fall** Semester 1 Comp 1 and **Spring** Semester 2 Comp 2 of the SENIOR YEAR.

JUNIOR OR SENIOR CLASSES : \* one semester = one semester

\*FINE ARTS : Humanities, Art, Cinema, Music Appreciation, Speech (2 classes replace one Full Credit of ART)

\*US HISTORY MUST TAKE BOTH Before AND After 1865 TWO SEMESTERS = (DUAL Diploma Class)

\*GOVERNMENT/Political Science Replaces HS Diploma Required GOV

\* MATH : College Algebra, Trig, PreCalc (ONLY if you passed Algebra 2)

\*COMPUTER: AFTER you have passed Fundamentals of Technology in High School)

\*GLOBAL STUDIES: Human Geography, World Civilization, Civics, Values and Ethics

\*FOREIGN LANGUAGE: (After you have taken at least one year of Spanish at the HS) CHEROKEE is offered

**\*SCIENCE**: **Biology** : General Enviro , Cellular, General Biology **Physical**: Chemistry, Earth , Geology, Astronomy, General Physical \* These classes require LABS and is a 4 hour class (MAY count as your 3<sup>rd</sup> Science)

SOCIAL SCIENCE: Psychology or Sociology

Remember: ALL Grades from Concurrent College WILL BE Posted on your Transcript and MAY impact your overall GPA at College AND SHS. Any GPA that falls below a 2.0 in a Concurrent Class will prevent the student from continuing Concurrent Enroll while in High School. IF you Fail to Notify the High School that you Dropped a Concurrent Class you will NOT be allowed to participate in any College Class the remaining of High School.

Step 1: Student must have the Pre-Act or ACT Test score of 19 or higher Composite and Subject Area

Step 2: Go to www.rsu.edu Create an account OR your College choice for Concurrent/Dual Enrollment

Step 3: Native American STUDENTS: It is your responsibility to meet any Scholarship offered from your Tribe.
